The Superior Court, County of Contra Costa (CCSC) announces its intent to award the contract for the Microsoft EA Renewal to PCM Gov, Inc.

As provided in the RFP # 1704-001, this Notice of Intent to Award is subject to execution of a written contract and, as a result, this Notice does NOT constitute the formation of a contract between the Superior Court, County of Contra Costa and the apparent successful vendor.

The vendor shall not acquire any legal or equitable rights relative to the contract services until a contract containing terms and conditions acceptable to Superior Court, County of Contra Costa is executed.

If the apparent successful vendor fails to negotiate and execute a contract with the Superior Court, County of Contra Costa, the Superior Court, County of Contra Costa may revoke the award and award the contract to the next highest ranked vendor, if any.

The Superior Court, County of Contra Costa further reserves the right to cancel this Notice of Intent to Award at any time prior to the execution of a written contract.

As per Chapter 7 of the Judicial Branch Contracting Manual this "Notice of Intent to Award" starts the 5 Court day period in which an unsuccessful vendor may file a vendor appeal. The protester will have 10 calendar days after CCSC receives the protest to submit all information as per section 13.2.2 of the Administrative Rules Governing Online Solicitation, to CCSC.
