**ORDER RE: TEMPORARY BAIL
SCHEDULE**

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, the Court hereby repeals the Emergency Bail Schedule implemented June 2020 in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. The Contra Costa County Felony Bail Schedule of January 1, 2020, is temporarily reinstated and ordered in effect until September 30, 2022, unless amended or repealed by the Court. Bail for misdemeanor offenses shall be set as follows until September 30, 2022, unless amended or repealed by the Court:

A defendant charged with a misdemeanor offense is entitled to release on her or his own recognizance unless release will compromise public safety or will not reasonably insure the defendant's appearance in accordance with the presumptive bail schedule set forth below:

- Offenses with maximum term of confinement 90 days = \$1,000
- Offenses with maximum term of confinement 180 days = \$5,000
- Offenses with maximum term of confinement 364 days = \$7,500

- Offenses involving acts of domestic violence, child abuse, or elder abuse = \$15,000
- 1st Offense DUI = \$5, 000
- 2nd Offense DUI = \$10,000
- 3rd Offense DUI = \$25,000
- Violation of misdemeanor probation = \$15,000.
