4. Defendant shall not use, possess any cannabis, controlled substances, narcotics or narcotic paraphernalia without a prescription from a licensed physician.
5. Defendant shall report to the police agency, as directed, to be booked for the offense(s).
6. Defendant shall pay victim restitution in the amount of \$ _____.
7. Complete _____ community service hours and show proof to the CPO. (For a list of community service options, contact the Volunteer Center of the East Bay – www.helpnow.org).
8. Defendant understands and agrees with the terms of pre-trial diversion.
9. Upon successful completion of diversion, please refer to section 1001.9 of the Cal. Penal Code regarding “Disclosure of Arrest” rights.
