Seeking Research Attorney – Juvenile Law

The Superior Court of Contra Costa County seeks an attorney with a minimum of 5 years of legal experience in their field and an active State Bar Membership to join its panel of Independent Contract Research Attorneys. The juvenile law research attorney will conduct legal research and prepare memoranda for petitions under Welfare and Institutions Code section 827 to release certain juvenile court records. Candidates must be available to work on location at the Walnut Creek courthouse, located at 640 Ygnacio Valley Rd.

Attorneys may not engage in the active practice of law in Contra Costa County in the case type they are assigned to while on the panel.

Contractor rate is \$50 per hour. The period of empanelment will be mutually decided between the Court and the Research Attorney. This position is at-will and limited-time. The Court cannot guarantee a specific number of hours, but anticipates the assignments will take 5-8 hours per week. The standard contract terms pare one year contract period with four one year options to extend.

The individual(s) selected for these positions will be required to successfully complete a criminal history check conducted by the Contra Costa County Office of the Sheriff. The fees for the background check will be paid by the Court.
